

Filing a Complaint Against Law Enforcement

If Law Enforcement are harassing, interfering with, or violating the individual civil rights of citizens, which are guaranteed under the Constitution, Charter of Rights, Bill of Rights, etc., then you have a duty and a responsibility to file a complaint. It is up to the citizens of this nation to take action to ensure our Constitutional Rights and Freedoms and the Rule of Law are upheld and protected.

Also consider exercising your right to contest tickets. There is a good possibility that tickets will be dismissed as they are in violation of your “guaranteed” rights under the Constitution and the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. See **“What To Do If You Get A Fine”**.
